

RECOVERED MATERIAL CERTIFICATION

- (a) As required by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (42 U.S.C. 6962(c)(3)(A)(i)), the offeror certifies, by signing this offer, that the percentage of recovered materials to be used in the performance of the Subcontract will be at least the amount required by the applicable Subcontract specifications.
- (b) The Subcontractor also shall estimate the percentage and dollar value of recovered materials, by material types which are specified in the SOW or attached exhibits, actually used in the performance of this Subcontract.
