1. Subcontract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act.
 - 1.1 Reference the regulations issued by the Secretary of Labor pursuant to the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (Public Law 91-54; 86 Stat. 96; 40 U.S.C. 327), entitled "Safety and Health Regulations for Construction" (29 CFR 1926), and to the California Administrative Code, Title 8 - Construction Safety Order, and General Industry Safety Orders.
 - 1.2 The Subcontractor will be required to comply with the Secretary's regulations and the California Administrative Code to the extent that any resulting subcontract involves construction.
2. Performance and Payment Bonds (for subcontracts greater than \$100K)
 - 2.1 Before final execution of any subcontract resulting from this RFP, the successful proposer will be required to submit "Performance" and "Payment" bonds. The penal sum of each such bond will be 100% of the subcontract Ceiling Price, or such other lesser amount as may be specified in the Specimen Subcontract.
 - 2.2 The space for entering the date of each bond must be left blank. JPL will insert the date on final subcontract execution by JPL. This date will be the effective date of the subcontract.
 - 2.3 In accordance with the provisions of the General Provision of the Specimen Subcontract entitled "Bonds," the penal sum of the attached bonds will not be increased during contract performance, unless specifically requested by JPL. Any increase in the penal sum will be set forth in a supplemental agreement to the subcontract, along with the increase in bond premium, if any.
