

**ESTIMATE OF PERCENTAGE OF RECOVERED MATERIAL CONTENT FOR EPA-DESIGNATED PRODUCTS**

[CT, FP – NR&D, FP – R&D, LH/T&M, T&MC, CREI, FPC, A – E, CIS – 10/10] [52.223-9 – 08/00]

(This Article applies to subcontracts exceeding \$100,000.)

(a) Definitions.

“Postconsumer material” means a material or finished product that has served its intended use and has been discarded for disposal or recovery, having completed its life as a consumer item. Postconsumer material is a part of the broader category of recovered material.

“Recovered Material” means waste materials and by-products recovered or diverted from solid waste, but the term does not include those materials and by-products generated from, and commonly reused within, an original manufacturing process.

- (b) The Subcontractor shall estimate the percentage and dollar value of recovered materials used in Subcontract performance, including, if applicable, the percentage of postconsumer material content by material types. The Subcontractor shall submit this estimate to the JPL Environmental Affairs Program Office (EAPO) through the JPL Subcontracts Manager annually or if this subcontract term is less than one year, upon completion of this subcontract.
