A. Reminder: Proposal Due Date

All Proposers are reminded that the PAST PERFORMANCE VOLUME of your proposal is due at JPL NOT LATER THAN 3:00 P.M. PACIFIC STANDARD TIME ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 12TH, 2002.

IF YOUR PAST PERFORMANCE VOLUME IS RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE AND TIME IT WILL BE CONSIDERED LATE. LATE PROPOSALS WILL BE TREATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH RFP GENERAL INSTRUCTION 4.0, LATE PROPOSALS.

All other Proposal Information remains due not later than 3:00 P.M. on Tuesday, November 19th, 2002.

B. Cut-off for Questions Regarding the RFP.

JPL has determined that any questions submitted in response to the RFP must be received not later than 12:00 Noon, Pacific Standard Time, on Wednesday, November 13th, 2002. JPL will make every effort to answer all RFP questions received by this time. The answers to any such questions will be contained in one final RFP Addendum, which will be issued to the email list on the evening of Wednesday, November 13th, 2002, and posted to the web site on Thursday, November 14th, 2002.

Should no additional questions be received between 5:00 P.M. on November 11th, 2002, and 12:00 Noon on Wednesday, November 13th, 2002, it is anticipated that this Addendum Eleven will be the last RFP Addendum issued prior to submission of all outstanding proposal information on November 19th, 2002.

C. Carryover from Addendum Eight:

Question 14:

Reference: Addendum 5, Section E, Question 4 concerning the purchasing and inventory module of Maximo. Answer a. says that JPL will not implement the purchasing and inventory modules Maximo 5.1. Answer b. says that JPL will not mandate how the contractor will perform the purchasing and inventory

functions.

Question: Will JPL allow the new contractor to install/implement the purchasing and inventory modules in Maximo 5.1 for M&O Contractor use if the contractor provides system administration for these modules?

Answer: In the interest of program continuity, JPL does not plan to implement either the purchasing or the inventory modules in the JPL system. JPL will require the M&OS Contractor to input labor, material, and subcontracted services data in the appropriate fields of the modules that JPL will implement. JPL plans to perform system administration on the JPL system.

D. Questions received between November 5th, 2002 and November 11th, 2002:

1. Question: Does the solicitation contain a Variation in Quantities clause?

Answer: The RFP does not contain a Variation in Quantities clause. Should a proposer decide to propose such a clause, it should be treated as an exception to the Specimen Contract Statement of Work in accordance with RFP General Instruction 9.2.

2. Question: Does JPL intend to amend/replace Section 4.0, Applicable Documents, of Article 1 of the Specimen Contract?

Answer: Yes, JPL will update Section 4.0/Article 1 to reflect the current document revision numbers and dates as appropriate.

3. Question: Does JPL plan to provide the specimen contract in MS Word?

Answer: No, JPL does not plan to do this.

4. Reference: Building 202 UPS System.

Question: Will JPL provide additional information such as manufacturer, size (kVa rating), number and type of battery jars or cells for this system?

Answer: Proposers are referred to the answer to Question 2 in Addendum Number 10.
