

The following Documents will be deleted from Exhibit III, Applicable Documents List, dated 03/17/04. They are:

Delete JPL D-5813, Fracture Control Implementation Plan from the Applicable Documents List.

Exceptions to JPL documentation shall be requested through a waiver. Each exception shall state the requirement being waived, the requirement that will be used in its place (if any), a justification for the deviation, and a risk assessment. The Project will review and disposition the waiver with the following outcomes: accept the waiver, accept the waiver contingent upon deployment of a mitigation plan, or reject the waiver. The decision-making process shall be documented.

Finally, delete JPL CS515574, Hybrid Integrated Circuit, Crystal Oscillator, from both the Specification and the Applicable Documents List.
