The following are questions submitted by the Source List in regards to the RFP:

1. Please clarify what you see a round trip consisting of. This is on your pricing page. Does this include delivery time or just time from our facility to JPL?

A trip should equal the standing time of the driver (if any) at the warehouse, travel time to and from JPL and standing time for the driver at Lab as the product is loaded or unloaded by the company's other employees under the regular contract labor rates. At the company's discretion the driver could also help to physically load or unload the product and JPL would pay for his time separately from the fixed cost trip charge of standing and traveling.

2. The 'Determination of Lowest Overall Price' form indicates under the Warehouse Rate for 30,000 Cubic Feet as the approximate requirements. Was this meant to be square feet and not cubic feet, as during the site visit the space requirements seemed to be much higher?

30,000 cubic feet is correct. This represents only space used for storage of inventory and does not include aisles or loading areas.
