

**ADDENDUM NO. 6 TO JPL RFP JTD-565939, dated April 25, 2003**

The following question has been raised in regard to the subject RFP. JPL's answer follows:

**Q. Can a JPL employee be a co-Investigator or subcontractor on a JPL contract?**

A. No! Also, the JPL employee cannot even be involved free of charge either in the preparation of a Contractor's proposal or in the work of the Contract as a co-Investigator/subcontractor once the effort is awarded/executed.

The reason for the above is not to doubt the integrity of the JPL evaluation process or of those involved, but it is to avoid all possible appearances of any kind of conflict of interest to a third party.
