



## Landing in Living Rooms: LEGO Models of NASA Mars Rover and Helicopter

"A new STEM-themed kit developed in cooperation with NASA-JPL is designed to spark kids' interest in engineering and space via traditional toys and augmented reality.

While NASA's <u>Perseverance rover</u> and <u>Ingenuity helicopter</u> are busy exploring Mars, one-tenth-scale buildable models of them have begun touching down in homes around the globe.

Developed in cooperation with NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Southern California, a new LEGO Technic building set is based on the real rover and helicopter, which have been roaming through Mars' <u>Jezero Crater</u> since <u>landing there</u> in February 2021. In its search for signs of ancient microbial life, Perseverance has been collecting Mars rock and soil samples for potential return to Earth by a future campaign. And Ingenuity became the first aircraft to perform <u>powered</u>, <u>controlled flight</u> on another planet, and since then has gone on to complete more than 50 additional flights."

**New NASA Vendor Database!** 



The purpose of the NVDB is to compile a database of vendors, both large and small, who wish to do business with NASA. The NVDB is utilized for NASA's OSBP for outreach communications and Office of Procurement (OP) for market research and acquisition planning. The database may also be used by industry when searching for capabilities to support subcontracting opportunities or for networking purposes. Vendors can also include a capability statement and sign-up to receive e-mail alerts for NASA procurement notices posted on <u>Sam.gov</u> for contract opportunities

By registering your business into the NVDB, you are expressing your interest in doing business with NASA and agreeing to share key information and capabilities of your business with NASA OSBP, NASA OP personnel and other registered vendors.

Registration in <u>Sam.gov</u> is required prior to registration in the NVDB.
